Covid-19 Safety Procedures & Camp Activities

Covid-19 Safety Procedures: Physical distancing practices in place and games to encourage this healthy practice. Frequent built-in handwashing times. Staff will wear masks when indoors with children or when closer than 6 feet to them; children are required to wear masks when indoors and within 6th feet of others.

School Work: We will set aside 2 hours a day for students to do their school work. If there is an online class the student needs or wishes to attend, let us know at sign in so we can be sure the student is able to attend. Please send school work for the students to work on; if a student has nothing to do or finishes early we can give them something for them to silently work on while other students are working. We can aid students in their school work but cannot be held reasonable for their grades.

Activities: Fun and engaging activities such as crafts, hiking, games, special lessons and guests, and a daily devotional

Lunch: We will provide lunch and a snack for them each day. Feel free to bring a packed lunch as well

Camp Sign-in

Camp begins with check-in at 9:00 am outside of the Lodge for all Students. After check-in is complete students can enter the Lodge and meet their staff member for the day.

What to expect :

1. **Sign-in:** A drop-off and pick-up system will be in place outside our Lodge. Each child will be temp checked at drop off with a no-touch thermometer. If your child is sick or becomes sick while they are here they will be sent home immediately.
2. **Medication:** The staff will review your health form to make sure we have all the necessary information. All medications (both prescription and over-the-counter) must be turned in to the camp staff when checking in. Medications must be in their original containers with camper name and dosage instructions printed on them. Special arrangements can be made for any campers needing to carry medications such as inhalers and EpiPens.

Camp Pick-up

Camp ends each day at 3:30. Pick-up will be outside the Lodge, the same location as sign in

What to expect:

1. **Sign-out:** When arriving to pick-up your child, come to the station set up outside the Lodge and we will bring the student out to you.
2. **Early Pickup:** If your child needs to leave early any of the days during the week at camp, please let staff know in the morning
3. **Pick-Up:** At sign in we will ask if you will be the same person picking up. If not we will ask for a name and require ID from the individual picking up the student.
4. **Late Fee:** If your student is picked up after 3:30 there will be a late fee of \$8 per student.
